

Definition of Professional Duty extended to include duty to warn

The Definition of **Professional Duty** shall not apply but shall be replaced by the following:

Professional**Duty**

shall mean any

- (a) design and/or specification;
- (b) supervision of construction or engineering works provided that the construction or engineering works are not carried out:
 - (i) by **You** or by a **Connected Person**; or
 - (ii) by any sub-contractor of **Yours** or of a **Connected Person**;
- (c) preparation of a feasibility study;
- (d) carrying out of technical calculations or the provision of technical information;
- (e) surveying;
- (f) any duty to warn;
- (g) other activities listed in the **Schedule**;

provided always that the work is undertaken by or under the direction, control and supervision of someone:

- (i) who is a partner, member, director or principal of **Your** firm or an **Employee**; and
- (ii) who is a Fellow, Professional Associate or Member of the Royal Institute of British Architects or the Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors or who has not less than 5 years' experience of that type of work
